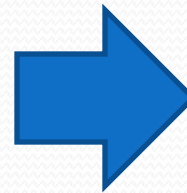


Fotobounce Highlights

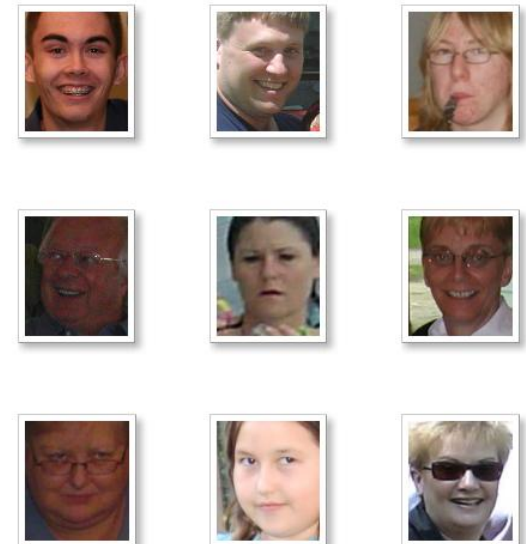
1. Scan images looking for faces
2. Tag people in photos
3. Arrange photos into albums (optional)
4. Share with friends and family

Fotobounce Scanning

1. Based on the folder you selected Fotobounce will scan all photos in that folder looking for faces.
2. When a face is found it is labelled unidentified.



Unidentified Faces



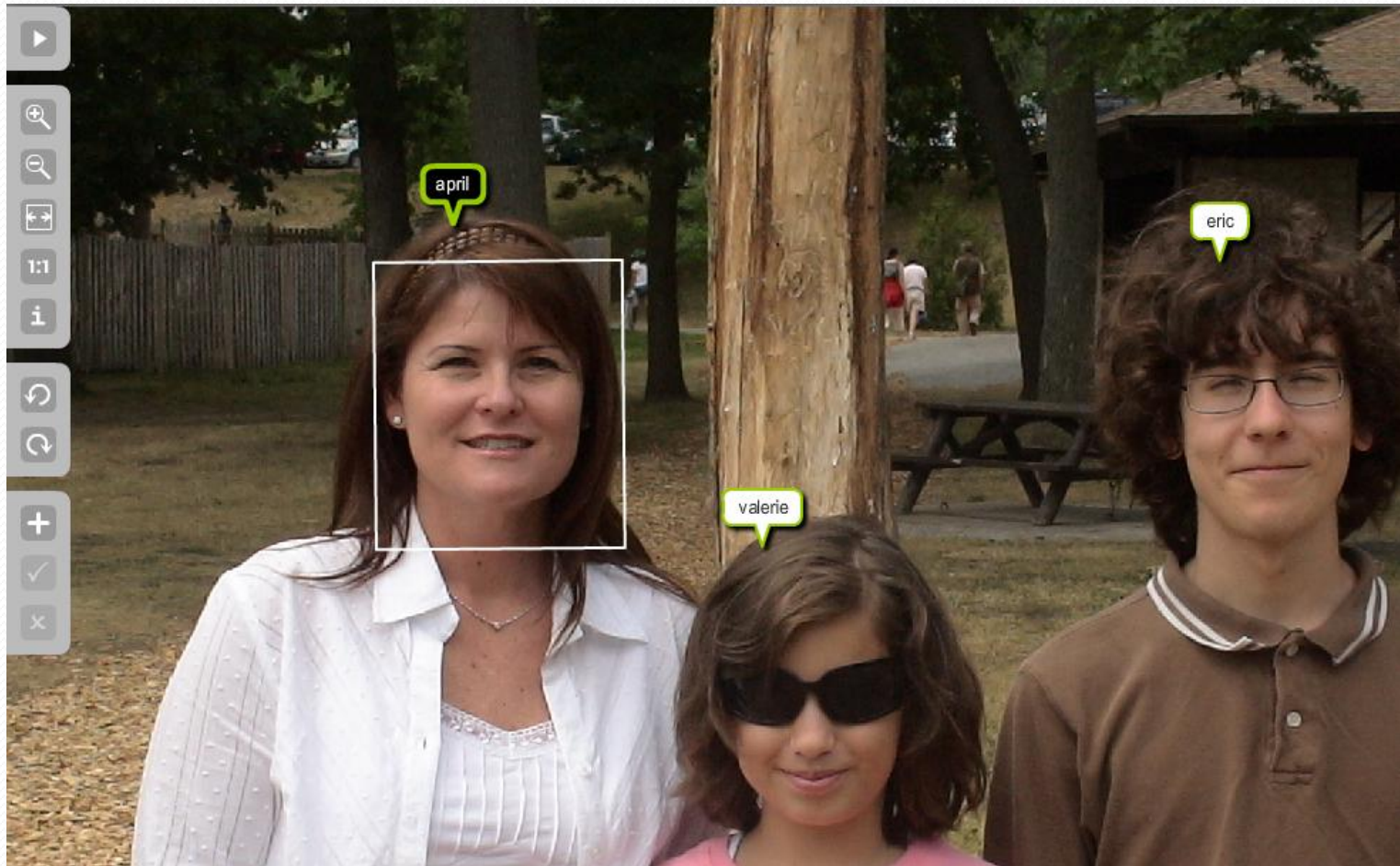
Fotobounce Tagging

1. Attach names to faces in your photos
2. Fotobounce will help using Face Recognition
3. Delete faces you don't know (only keep the good stuff)

View your photos in the Fotobounce viewer



Tag the faces with names



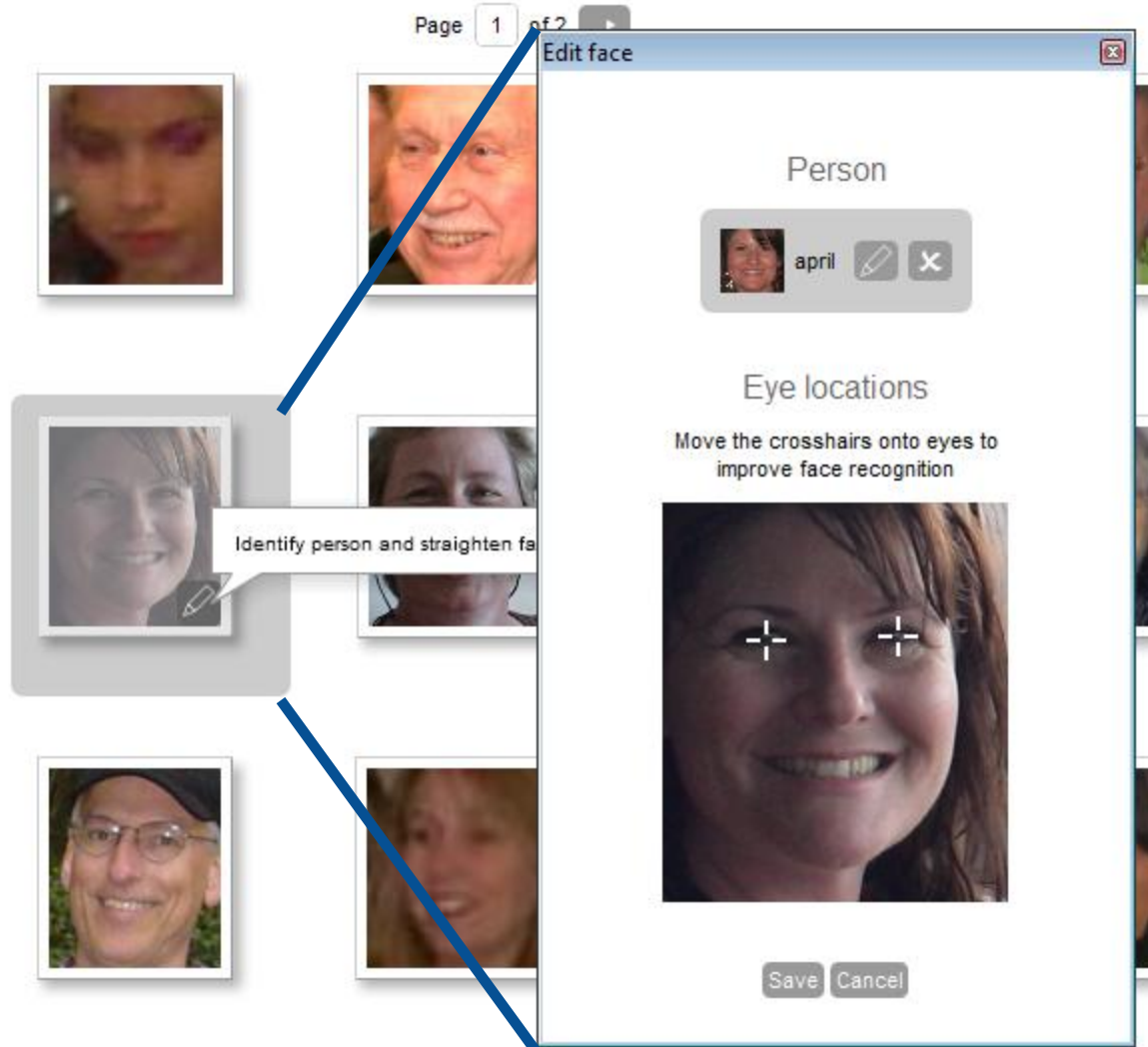
Double-click tags with question marks to enter name; or place a manual tag around a face by clicking the plus-sign on left and drawing a box with mouse around face.

Or, tag unidentified faces directly

Click on the edit icon on the bottom right corner of any face thumbnail and that will popup the name and eye location editor.

Start typing the name of a person and if there is a match it will show a list of names. Select the existing name or continue entering the new name.

Press Enter or click the Save button. Adjusting eye coordinates is optional, but it will improve recognition results.



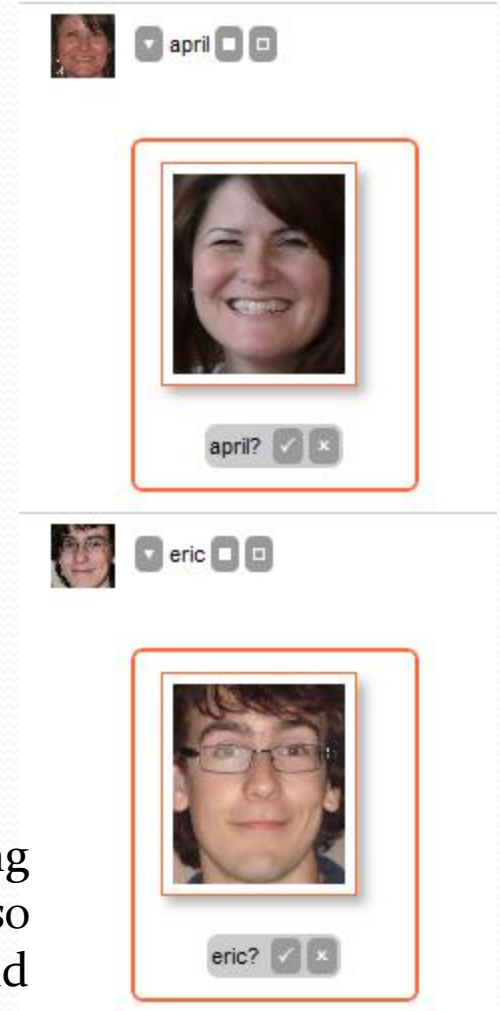
Fotobounce uses face recognition



Fotobounce uses the tagged faces to make suggestions about other matches for that person in other photos.



Suggestions are confirmed by clicking the check mark icons. You can also select multiple people at one time and click the check mark at the top of the screen.

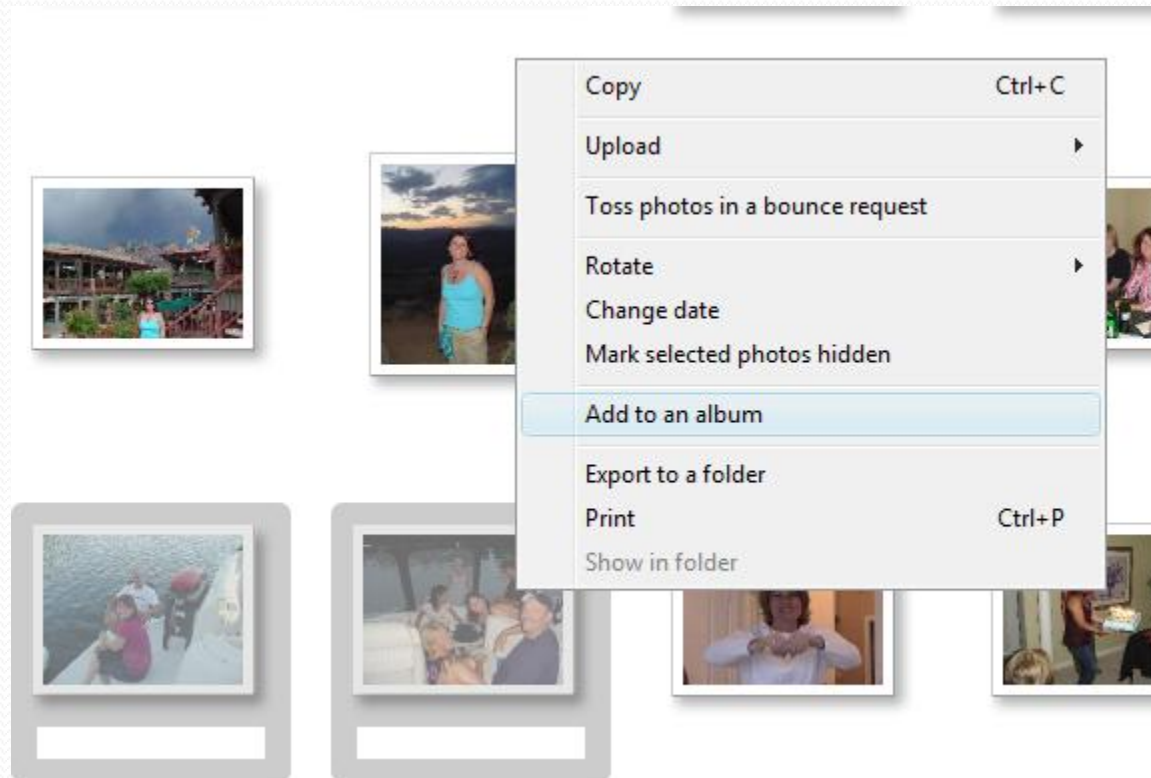


Fotobounce Albums

1. Put photos into albums by event, place, keyword or general collection.
2. Just select any group of photos based on date, groups, etc. and place into an album.

Fotobounce Albums

- Select a few photo thumbnails, right-click, then add to an existing album or create a new one. Then they are permanently saved in that album.




Fotobounce Private Sharing

1. Confirm your email address.
2. Set your privacy settings.
3. Create your own private network by inviting friends and family to join you.
4. Browse their photos, and copy photos you like in full resolution with all people tags to your local Fotobounce library.

Confirm Email Address

- For each email you enter, you are sent a code which is entered on this screen to confirm the address is correct.

Set privacy settings

- Enter name for your Fotobounce account and a profile picture.
- Turn sharing on and set a description of your photo library.
- Turn on sharing by album type. You can also override these settings for each individual album.

I use a cool photo organizer called Fotobounce. I have some great photos of you and would like to share those photos with you. All you need to do is download and install Fotobounce for free.

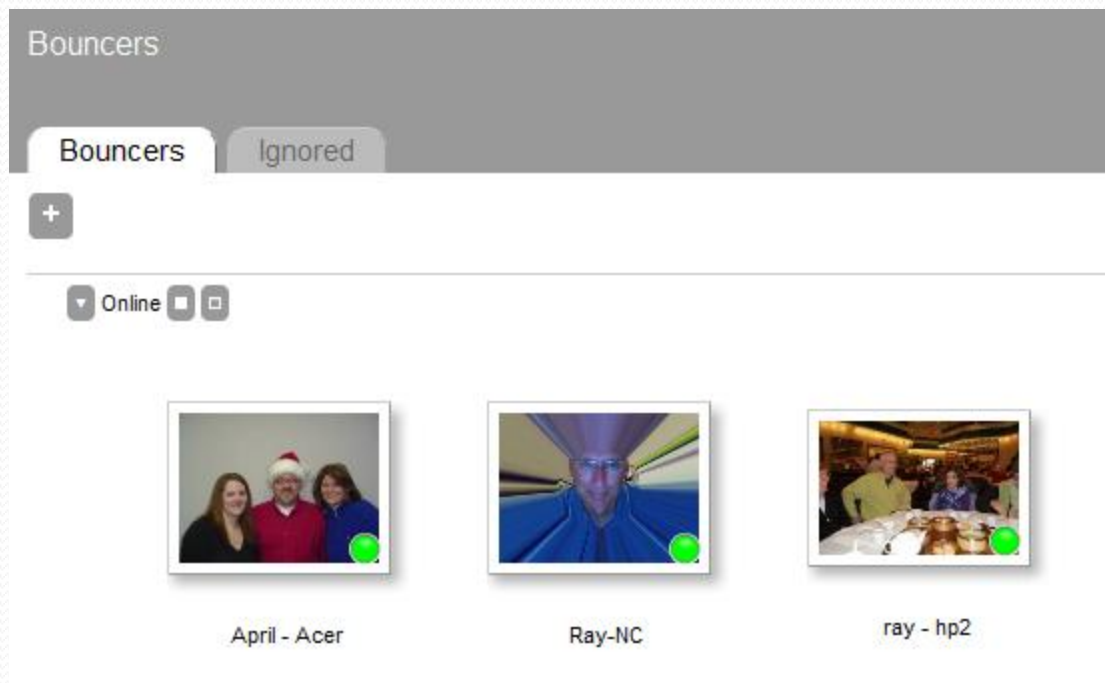
Once you install it you will get a message saying that you have been invited to join with other Fotobounce friends. Accept my invitation and you will have access to my public photos.

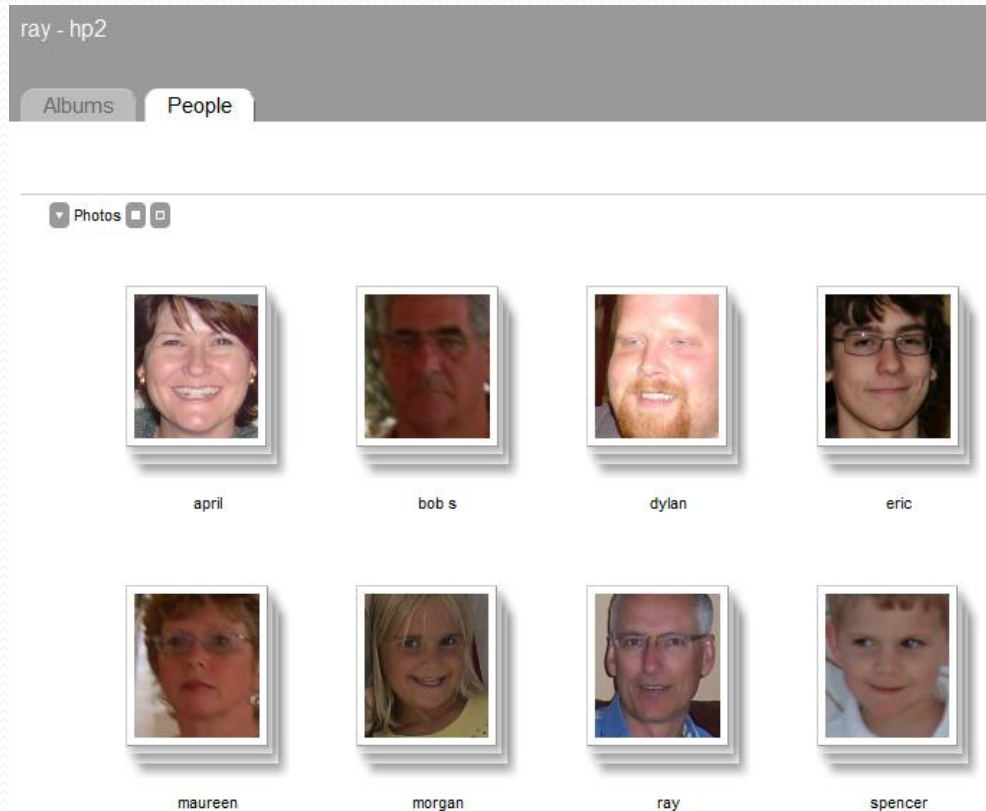
View your Bouncers

- Once your friends accept your invitation, they show up in your list of “Bouncers”.
- Those Bouncers that are online will have a green indicator and can be browsed.



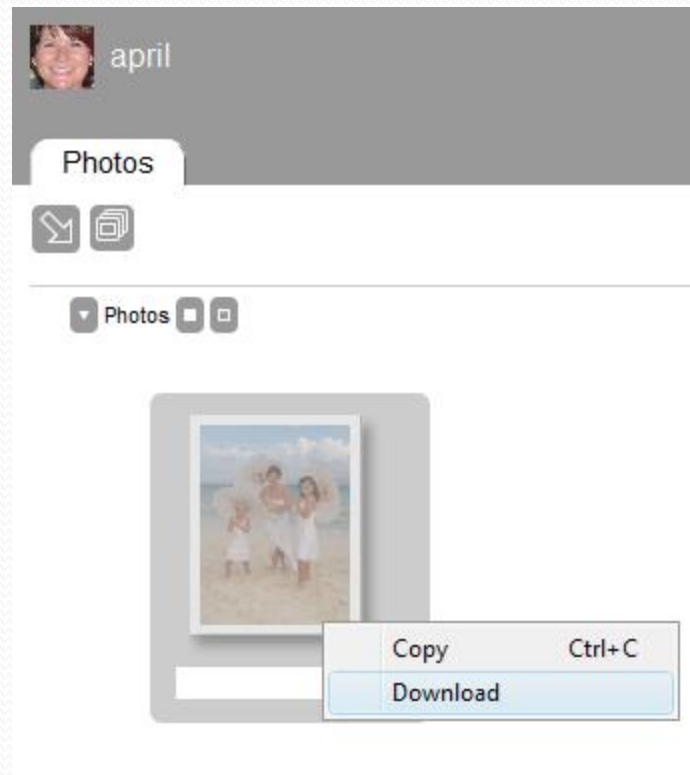
Browse your Bouncers

- You can browse Bouncer photos by people or by album. Whatever photos they have made public will be visible.



Copy from your Bouncers

- If you find a photo you like, right-click and copy that to a local album. The caption and people info will also be copied – saving you time!

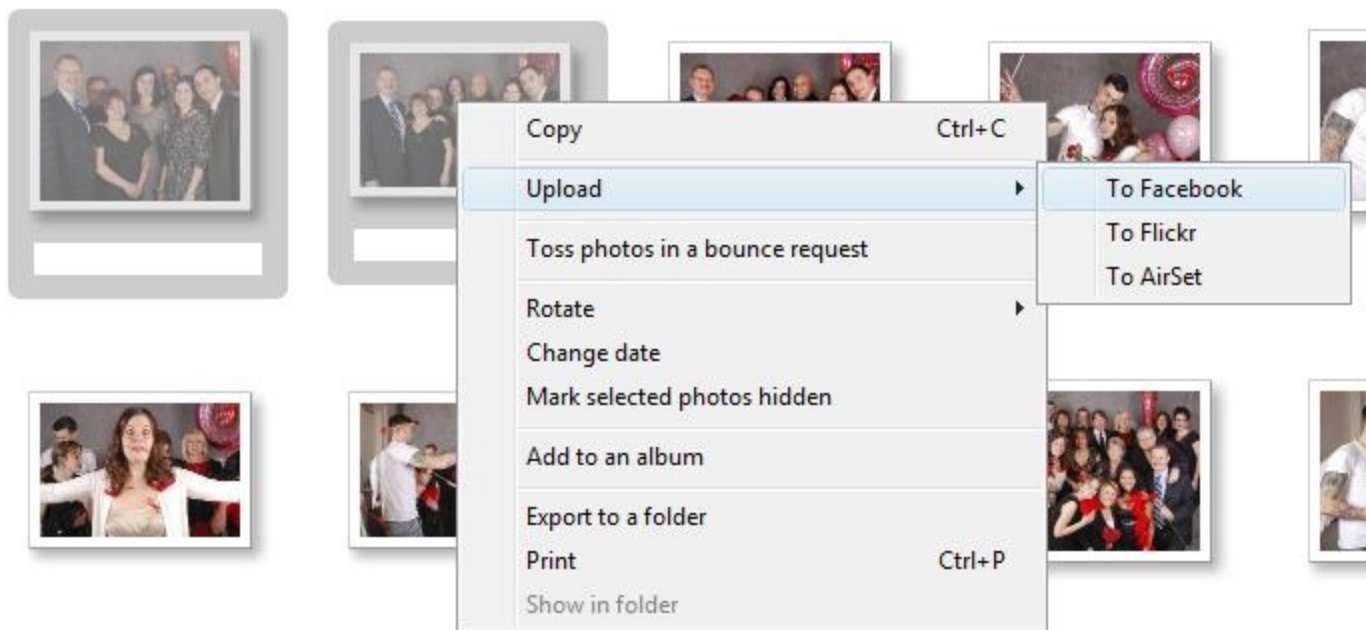


Fotobounce Public Sharing

1. Copy an album to Facebook, Flickr, or AirSet.
2. Or, copy an album from a Facebook, Flickr or AirSet friend to your local Fotobounce albums.

Copy album to Facebook

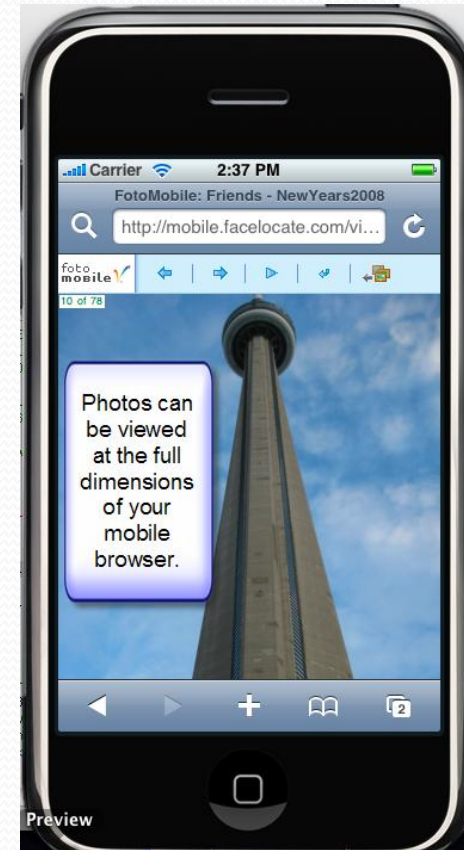
1. Select individual photos or an entire album.
2. Right-click and select your target location.



Mobile access to Fotobounce



1. Turn on remote access under the Sharing Setup. Choose username and password.
2. Login at <http://fotobounce.mobi>
3. Browse your photos remotely from any mobile device with a web browser.
